

Knicks defeat Wolves by 27

New York Knicks defeated the Minnesota Timberwolves 132-105 Tuesday night.

Corey Brewer made 9 of 10 shots for 22 points in the loss. The Timberwolves lost to the Milwaukee Bucks by 33 a few days earlier.

Brewer's former Florida Gator teammate led all scorers with 28 points and 10 boards. Al Harrington scored 26 and Wilson Chandler had 20 despite a strained left groin for the Knicks.

Ramon Sessions finished with 20 points and fellow reserve Sasha Pavlovic had 16.

"We knew that they just lost by 50 at home, so we knew they were going to come out with some kind of start," Sessions said. "But that start didn't end. They kept it up for the whole game."

The Timberwolves started the game down 15-0 before scoring their first basket of the game.

Minnesota hosts the Cleveland Cavaliers tonight.
